



# Arizona Tax Credit

## Give your School Credit! What is a Tax Credit?

A tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar reduction in the actual tax owed to the State of Arizona. It reduces your tax liability by the amount you donate, **up to \$400 for married couples** and **\$200 for single or head of household**. For example, if you donate \$400 to a Liberty District school activity, you reduce your Arizona state tax bill by \$400, or your tax refund will be increased by \$400. Multiple tax credit donations can be made as long as the total sum of all donations do not exceed the limits of \$200 for single and \$400 for married couples. Tax credit donations are used to fund extra-curricular programs and activities. Families may take advantage of the Tax Credit option to help cover activity fees. It is a Win-Win opportunity for you, for kids, and for education!
